A warm welcome to our Christmas Concert - and thanks for coming along tonight at this busy time of year. We're really looking forward to an enjoyable evening of wonderful festive music to get us & you in the Christmas spirit, and to hear you singing along even on the pieces we've not provided words to.

As well as being our favourite concert of the year, our Christmas Concert is also one at

which I find myself reflecting back to the past year (which went way too quickly) and beyond. My first concert with the band was Christmas 1982, the year that Stop The Cavalry was released, and I have many happy memories of the 1980s Christmas Concerts at Heathlands school, which saw 60 players & 100+ audience squeezed into the school hall before it was enlarged. Our last Christmas Concert of the 1980s was



also the last concert our founder Sid Cooper conducted, as he passed away suddenly in January 1990.

My brother kept the band going through the early 1990s and I then took over baton duties



in 1994, with Christmas 1995 being the first Christmas Concert I solely conducted. Shortly afterwards I moved the Christmas Concerts to West Bergholt Church, with 50+ players just about fitting into the area between the organ, the altar and the pews...the latter holding as many people as we could squeeze in. Space was so tight I ended up conducting from the middle of the audience.

Eventually the Christmas Concert became so popular that we had to find a bigger venue...which led us to discover this gem of a church for our first concert here in Christmas 2012. Since then we've played the majority of our Christmas Concerts here, other than our most recent Christmas Concerts with school choirs at



St Botolph's Colchester, so we're delighted to be back here again this year.

As always, our Christmas Concert is a fun & relaxed evening where we celebrate another busy & successful year for the band by wearing daft hats and festive jumpers. You are of course welcome to join in with that, as well as with any of the pieces we play tonight...and remember, a set of keys can manage a pretty good sleigh bells impression if shaken firmly enough.
